Please save the date for the U.S. Department of Energy Office of Nuclear Energy (DOE-NE)-5 National Reactor Innovation Center (NRIC) Program Review meeting that will be held on the week of **March 31 – April 04, 2024**, at the Idaho National Laboratory (INL) within the Energy Innovation Laboratory (EIL) Building in Idaho Falls, ID. In addition, the DOE-NE-5 Regulatory Framework Modernization (RFM) program meeting will be held the same week, following the NRIC Program Review, at the same location for interested parties.

Meetings will have a virtual option, but in-person attendance is encouraged. **Optional facility tours** will be included to include tours of DOME and MSTEC where significant progress has been made.

The goals of the NRIC Program Review are to facilitate program integration, provide context and high-level objectives, review the accomplishments over the past year, engage with stakeholders, solicit feedback, and to discuss FY 2025 research and development work scope and priorities.
